In addition, three types of information will be gathered if the Commission agrees. The first is selecting speakers outside of government to talk with the Commission. If the Commission agrees, invitations to speak could be extended to, in no particular order: Ed Kraus, Mayor of Solon; Council President of Mentor; Tom Wagner, member of Lakewood Charter Review Commission who wanted to change the form of government to Council-Manager; representative from the Euclid Charter Review; and Earl Leikin, Mayor of Shaker Heights.

A second source of information is interviews with past members of Council, Mayors and staff. Currently, former mayors Dennis Wilcox, Alan Rapoport and Jack Boyle will be interviewed. Boyle was involved with the last charter review. Other possible interviewees will be investigated and the Commission may suggest additional persons.

The Third source of information is community groups and businesses. Future Heights and Noble Neighbors will be interviewed and/or invited to speak to the Commission. A member of the Commission suggested several business representers. The list is attached as Supplementary Materials. The Commission needs to finalize the list and determine the questions they would want to ask.
