

ORDINANCE NO. 020-2024(CRR), *First
Reading*

An Ordinance authorizing funding for lifeguard positions for community swim events at the Cleveland Heights University Heights High School Pool.

WHEREAS, there is a need for indoor swim facilities for City residents particularly during the winter season; and

WHEREAS, this Council supports the idea of residents utilizing Heights High School pool {the "Pool") when it is not needed for school purposes; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the safety and well-being of our community members utilizing the Pool that lifeguards be present when residents are swimming; and

WHEREAS, this Council therefore proposes this Ordinance to provide funding for lifeguards for community swimming events; and

WHEREAS, through the passage of this Ordinance we affirm our dedication to providing a safe aquatic recreational space for City residents, particularly our students and families who wish to use the Pool.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cleveland Heights, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. This Council hereby allocates up to Twenty-five Thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) annually for the costs of providing certified lifeguards at the Heights High School Swimming Pool for the period of September 1 through May 31.

SECTION 2. Notice of the passage of this Ordinance shall be given by publishing the title and abstract of contents, prepared by the Director of Law, once in one newspaper of general circulation in the City of Cleveland Heights.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time permitted by law.
