

RESOLUTION NO. 054-2024(COTW),
First Reading

A Resolution recognizing and congratulating the Cleveland Heights Lutheran East boys' basketball team for winning their second-straight Division III state championship; and declaring the necessity that this legislation become immediately effective as an emergency measure.

WHEREAS, the Cleveland Heights Lutheran East boys' basketball team won their third state title in the last four years on March 24, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Cleveland Heights Lutheran East defeated Canal Winchester Harvest Prep, 45-36; and

WHEREAS, in his final high school game, Lutheran East senior and Michigan State signee Jesse McCulloch had a game-high 18 points to go with nine rebounds and four blocks; and

WHEREAS, coach Sam Liggins said "it's a testament to our entire school. You don't achieve any of that without that kind of support."

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cleveland Heights, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. This Council recognizes the hard work and dedication of the Lutheran East boys' basketball team, and congratulates them on their victory at the OHSA Division III boys' basketball state championship game.

SECTION 2. Notice of passage of this Resolution shall be given by publishing the title and abstract of its contents, prepared by the Director of Law, once in one newspaper of general circulation in the City of Cleveland Heights.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective as an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Cleveland Heights, such emergency being the need to celebrate the Lutheran East boys' basketball team's state championship win in a timely manner. Wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) or more members elected or appointed to Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after all the earliest time allowed by law.
