

RESOLUTION NO. 239-2024(MSES), *First Reading*

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to renew the City's service agreement with Spectrum to continue and upgrade internet service for City Hall; and declaring the necessity that this legislation become immediately effective as an emergency measure.

WHEREAS, Charter Communications, Inc., through the trade name, Spectrum, offers dedicated fiber internet service; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to renew the City's service agreement with Spectrum to continue and upgrade internet service for City Hall to support daily government operations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cleveland Heights, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to renew the City's agreement with Spectrum to provide internet service for City Hall. The agreement shall be substantially in accordance with the draft on file with the Clerk of Council and shall be approved as to form by the Director of Law. The agreement and related insurance policies and expenses shall be at a cost not to exceed \$65,940 and shall contain such other terms as recommended by the Mayor and Director of Law.

SECTION 2. Notice of the passage of this Resolution shall be given by publishing the title and abstract of its contents, prepared by the Director of Law, once in one newspaper of general circulation in the City of Cleveland Heights, or by posting the full text of this Resolution to the City of Cleveland Heights website.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective as an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Cleveland Heights, such emergency being to prevent disruption to daily government operations at City Hall. Wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more of the members elected or appointed to this Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
