

RESOLUTION NO. 101-2025(PSH), *First Reading*

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement with Krueger International, Inc. d/b/a Spacesaver Corporation through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program, for the provision of new lockers to be installed in the Police Department's locker rooms; and declaring the necessity that this legislation be effective immediately as an emergency measure.

WHEREAS, the Police Locker Room Capital Improvement Project was initially budgeted for FY 2024, but reprioritized as part of ARPA-related strategic budgeting;

WHEREAS, Section 9.48 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes political subdivisions to participate in cooperative purchasing programs without obtaining competitive bids; and

WHEREAS, Section 171.12 of the Cleveland Heights Codified Ordinances authorizes the purchase of machinery, materials, supplies, and other articles through the cooperative purchasing program formerly known as the National Joint Powers Alliance, now known as the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program, without obtaining competitive bids; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has determined that the selected labor and materials may be purchased through this Cooperative Purchasing Program at a lower price than could be obtained through bidding, and that it would be in the City's best interests to purchase said vehicle and equipment by this means.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cleveland Heights, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of Codified Ordinances Chapter 171 to the contrary, the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute all agreements and related documents with with Krueger International, Inc. d/b/a Spacesaver Corporation necessary the provision of new lockers to be installed in the Police Department's locker rooms and in accordance with Sourcewell Contract #091423-KII for an amount not to exceed One Hundred Ninety-Five Thousand, Eight Hundred Seventy-Five and 88/100 Dollars (\$195,875.88). All contracts hereunder shall be in a form approved by the Director of Law.


SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. Notice of the passage of this Resolution shall be given by publishing the title and abstract of its contents, prepared by the Director of Law, once in one

newspaper of general circulation in the City of Cleveland Heights, or by posting the full text of this Resolution on the City of Cleveland Heights website.

SECTION 4. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective as an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Cleveland Heights, such emergency being the need to commence the above-described improvements at the earliest possible convenience. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of five or more members elected or appointed to this Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.


