#20-06 – Delamere Drive Basement Flooding Relief

Paving work has been completed. Landscaping, final clean-up, and punch list work will be addressed in the next two weeks.

#21-01 – Shannon Road Resurfacing & Waterline Replacement

Intermediate paving has been completed, and Terrace is working on manhole and catch basin adjustments, ADA curb ramps, and spot curb replacement.

#21-02 – 2021 Street Resurfacing & ADA Curb Ramp Replacement Program

Work continues on the ADA curb ramp replacements, and surface course paving is tentatively scheduled to be completed (weather permitting) sometime during the week of September 6th.

#21-03 – 2021 Surface Treating Program

Partial depth pavement repairs, and sheet asphalt work have been completed. We anticipate the final chip seal application to be applied in the next week or two.

Street Maintenance Division

Street maintenance crews are out in full force this week hauling yard waste from Noble Road and leaf grindings from Lakeview Cemetery, repairing Cleveland Water cut-outs, and pot-hole patching and asphalting.

Forestry Division

Forestry crews are out performing tree pruning and removals.

Refuse & Recycling

The week of SEPTEMBER 6th will be bulk collection week. Bulk collection week is the first “full” week of the month (Monday-Friday (Saturday in the event of a holiday as will be the case during the week of the 6th)). Each resident can place up to four bulk items out for collection on their regularly scheduled collection day. Additional bulk items and non-bulk day pick-ups can be scheduled for a fee of \$10/item by using the following link below.
