

RESOLUTION NO. 144-2021 (PSH), *First Reading*

A Resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into an agreement with FARO Technologies, Inc. for the purchase of Three-Dimensional Focus Laser Scanners and associated materials and equipment for the Police Department through the United States General Services Administration; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, Three-Dimensional (3D) Focus Laser Scanners allow for the use of certain data to be imported into software for analysis and reporting of the captured data; and

WHEREAS, 3D Focus Laser Scanners capture distance dimensions and area and volume calculations, among other data, and analysis and documentation can be carried out quickly, precisely and reliably using scanned data; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has determined there is a need for 3D Focus Laser Scanners to combat and prevent crime; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Sections 9.48 permits political subdivisions to participate in contract offerings from the federal government that are available to a political subdivision including, but not limited to, contract offerings from the general services administration.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and City Manager have determined that the selected equipment may be purchased from FARO Technologies, Inc. through the United States General Services Administration at a lower price than could be obtained through competitive bidding, and that it would be in the City's best interests to purchase said equipment by this means.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cleveland Heights, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Manager be, and she is hereby, authorized to enter into any and all agreements, and to sign any related documents, necessary for the purchase of Three-Dimensional Focus Laser Scanners and associated materials and equipment with FARO Technologies, Inc. through the United States General Services Administration, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 9.48. The agreement shall provide for the purchase of the selected equipment at a total cost not to exceed Seventy-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars and Ninety-Four Cents (\$72,824.94). All agreements hereunder shall be approved as to form by and subject to the final approval of the Director of Law

SECTION 2. Notice of the passage of this Resolution shall be given by publishing the title and abstract of its contents, prepared by the Director of Law, once in one newspaper of general circulation in the City of Cleveland Heights.


SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure

immediately necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Cleveland Heights, such emergency being the need to meet vendor deadlines and to equip the Police Department as soon as possible. Wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) or more of the members elected or appointed to this Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
